As a resident of Orleans Parish, I understand that because we have lost population, we must lose a certain number of state house representatives. I do not believe we Orleans Parish should lose 4 representatives however, and the current House Bill, as amended by Amendment 203 and Amendment 248 would dilute African-American voter representation unfairly and disproportionately. These amendments do not respect communities of interest, and they are far from compact.

I am asking that you reconsider your vote and support of HB1 with these amendments. I do not want my right to vote infringed upon.
