RE: Proposed Senate Redistricting Plan

Introduction

The Power Coalition is pleased to submit this proposed Senate redistricting plan for the state of Louisiana (Plan A2). The plan was developed adhering to federal and state redistricting criteria and guidelines. The criteria that were used to develop the House plan can be found in Appendix A.

One of the objectives of this plan was to maintain current district configurations. However, due to population shifts during the decade, some districts were altered significantly. Specifically, SD37 was moved from the northwest portion of the state to the “Plantation Country” area of the state to compensate for population changes. That said, many districts were able to maintain their existing configuration.

Majority Black District Comparison

The proposed Senate plan has ten majority Black districts (using AP BVAP)¹, while the Current plan also has 10. However, there are 11 majority “BCVAP” districts in the proposed plan, with 10 in the Current plan (SD5 increased from 49.23% to greater than 50%).

Comparative Redistricting Criteria Analysis of the Proposed Senate Plan and the Current Plan

The proposed House plan performs better than the Current Plan using several redistricting criteria. The proposed House plan performs equal or better in 6 of 6 criteria (see Table 2). Specifically, the House plan has five criteria that are better than the Current plans and one criterion (contiguity) that is equal.

The six criteria that were compared included: Equal Population (one-person-one-vote), contiguity, compactness, county & VTD/precinct² splits (political subdivision splits), and city splits (communities of interest).

¹ AP BVAP refers to “Any Part” Black Voting Age Population. This includes in person in the decennial survey that is above the age of 18 and select Black single race or Black in addition to any other race. BCVAP refers to Black Citizen Voting Age Population which includes those person who are citizens of the US and are above the age of 18. The AP BVAP comes from the decennial census while the BCVAP comes from the American Community Survey (ACS).

² VTDs are similar to precincts, however, VTDs are generated using census blocks and are created by the Census Bureau. Most state’s use VTDs when developing statewide legislative plans.

Redistricting Criteria & Description Sheet

Redistricting Criteria

All plans were developed using the Joint Rule No. 21. Redistricting criteria. A summary version of the criteria includes:

- A. To promote the development of constitutionally and legally acceptable redistricting plans, the Legislature of Louisiana adopts the criteria contained in this Joint Rule, declaring the same to constitute minimally acceptable criteria for consideration of redistricting plans in the manner specified in this Joint Rule.
- B. Each redistricting plan submitted for consideration shall comply with the Equal Protection Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment and the Fifteenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution; Section 2 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; and all other applicable federal and state laws.
- C. Each redistricting plan submitted for consideration shall provide that each district within the plan is composed of contiguous geography.
- D. In addition to the criteria specified in Paragraphs B, C, G, H, I, and J of this Joint Rule, the minimally acceptable criteria for consideration of a redistricting plan for the House of Representatives, Senate, Public Service Commission, and Board of Elementary and Secondary Education shall be as follows:
- (1) The plan shall provide for single-member districts.
 - (2) The plan shall provide for districts that are substantially equal in population. Therefore, under no circumstances shall any plan be considered if the plan has an absolute deviation of population which exceeds plus or minus five percent of the ideal district population.
 - (3) The plan shall be a whole plan which assigns all of the geographies of the state.
 - (4) Due consideration shall be given to traditional district alignments to the extent practicable.
- E. Pertains to Congressional Districts
- F. Pertains to Supreme Court Districts
- G.(1) To the extent practicable, each district within a redistricting plan submitted for consideration shall contain whole election precincts as those are represented as Voting Districts (VTDs) in the most recent Census Redistricting TIGER/Line Shapefiles for the State of Louisiana which corresponds to the P.L. 94-171 data released by the United States Bureau of the Census for the decade in which the redistricting is to occur. However, if the redistricting plan is submitted after the year in which the legislature is required by Article III, Section 6, of the Constitution of Louisiana to reapportion, then to the extent practicable, the redistricting plan submitted for consideration shall contain whole election precincts as those are represented as VTDs as validated through the data verification program of the House and Senate in the most recent Shapefiles made available on the website of the legislature.
- (2) If a VTD must be divided, it shall be divided into as few districts as practicable using a visible census tabulation boundary or boundaries.
- H. All redistricting plans shall respect the established boundaries of parishes, municipalities, and other political subdivisions and natural geography of this state to the extent practicable. However, this criterion is subordinate to and shall not be used to undermine the maintenance of communities of interest within the same district to the extent practicable.
- I. The most recent P.L. 94-171 data released by the United States Bureau of the Census, as validated through the data verification program of the House and Senate, shall be the population data used to establish and for evaluation of proposed redistricting plans.

Maps

Statewide/District Zoom Maps

The statewide map shows all districts within the state of Louisiana. Included is an inset map for East Baton Rouge and Orleans Parishes. District maps that show a zoom of each priority district.

Statistical Data Reports

Population Summary

Two population summary reports are included. One report contains Voting Age Population (VAP) and Citizen Voting Age Population (CVAP). This report contains the following fields: Population, Deviation (Deviation from the ideal population), Dev% (percentage of deviation from the ideal population), Hispanic (Hispanic Origin), White (NH_Wh), and Any Part¹ Black (AP_Bl), Hispanic VAP (H18+_Pop), White VAP (NH18+_Wh), and Any Part Black VAP (18+_AP_Bl). Also included in this report are 2019 ACS CVAP data for each district including: Latino CVAP (LatCVAP19), White CVAP (WhCVAP19), and Black CVAP (BlkCVAP19).

Contiguity

Provides the number of separated (noncontiguous) parts for each district.

Compactness

Provides three compactness measures that quantify the irregular shape of the district. Reock, Polsby Popper, and Convex Hull.

Political Subdivision Splits between Districts

Includes the parishes and Voting Tabulation Districts (VTDs). VTDs are similar to precincts and are built using census blocks. The report includes the parishes and VTDs that are split and the portion of the population contained within each district.

Plan Components – Counties

Lists all counties (in whole and in part) contained within each district. The report includes total population and major races/ethnicities of the Hispanic/Latino (Hispanic_Origin), White (NH_Wh – Not Hispanic), and AP Black (AP_Bl – Any Part Black).

Plan Components – VTD/Precincts

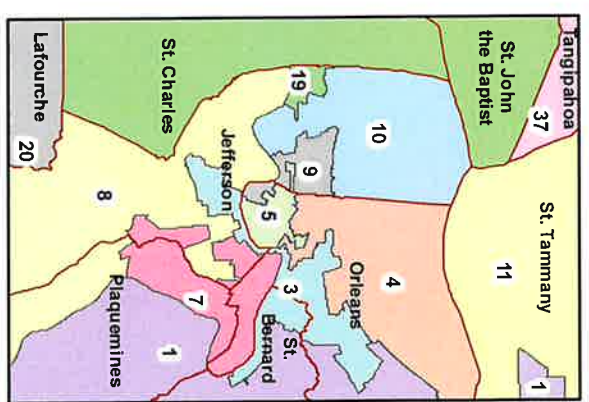
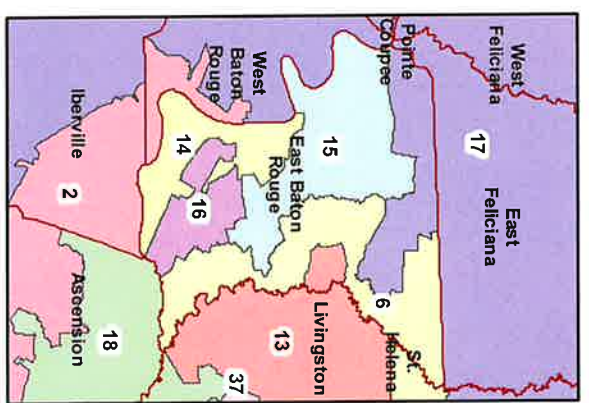
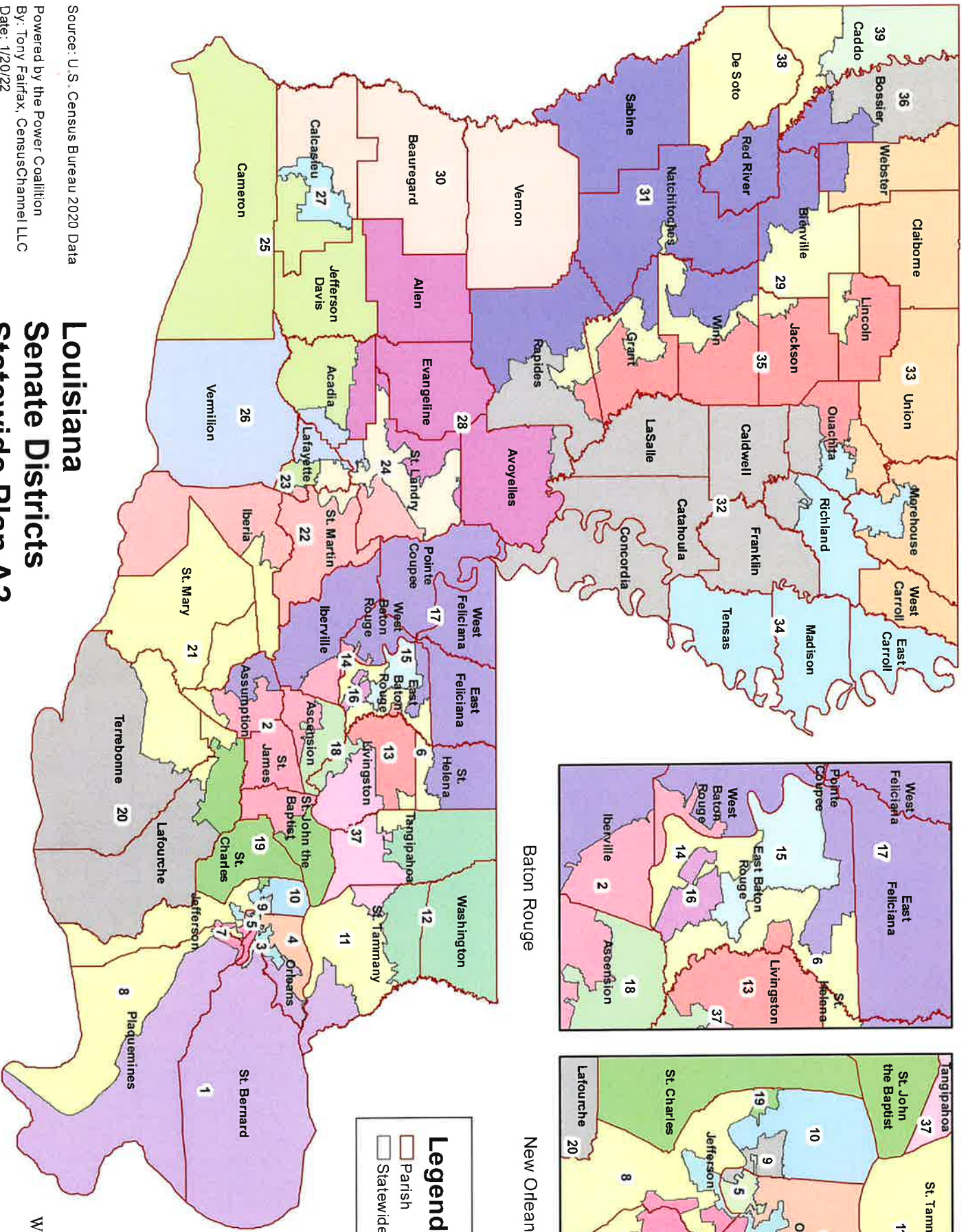
Lists all VTDs/Precincts contained within each district. The report includes the total population and major races/ethnicities of the Hispanic/Latino (Hispanic_Origin), White (NH_Wh – Not Hispanic), and AP Black (AP_Bl – Any Part Black).

¹¹¹ “Any Part” includes all persons who selected, on the decennial survey, a particular race regardless of whether it was alone or in combination with other racial groups. For instance, Any Part Black contains all persons who only select Black plus those that selected Black plus another race (e.g. Black and White; Black, White, and Asian, etc.)

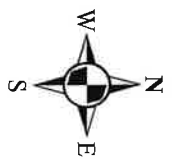
