Chairman Stefanski, Chairwoman Hewitt, I am Elizabeth M.Kogler, a resident of EBRP for 51 years, and a constituent of US Congressman Garret Graves Dist 6. I am a retired Medical Technologist of 40 years, a mother, grandmother and an avid community volunteer.

Based on the most recent census, there has been little change in this state's population. Due to this fact, I see no reason to make any major changes in our districts. Please keep the boundaries as they were last drawn under Obama's Presidency.

The law states that boundaries are to be redrawn only if population increases >5%. In Dist 6 the population increased only 5.2%, and Dist 4 it decreased only by 6.2%. Under these circumstances, the necessity of redrawing boundaries can only be explained by political gerrymandering. There are only 14-25% more Republicans or Democrats in each of the districts- not a significant difference. Please keep our boundaries in tact. This is fair to all and follows the existing laws.
