I am writing to ask that the legislature produces fair maps that give every Louisianan a chance for proper representation.

Our state is 40% minority and that is not reflected in the demographics of the state legislature. In fact, since the last redistricting process 10 years ago there has been an increase the minority population and a decrease in the white population in the state. This shift should be reflected in how the communities are represented in the government.

Currently, the state legislature does not fairly represent the people, a small minority of people have most of the power. For example, 75% of Louisianans support raising the minimum wage, but bills that support this do not make it through the legislative process because of who holds the power.

Give more power to the people, draw fair maps!
