- Algiers Point (not the suburban parts of Algiers)
- Esplanade Ridge and Faubourg St. John
- Lafayette Square
- Coliseum Square
- Lower Garden District
- Garden District.

Our historic neighborhoods are key to the reason so many people live in, work in, and visit New Orleans. Please consider this matter carefully.
