#### Requests for Redistricting of Louisiana districts

1. Make the boundaries simple, reasonably straight.
2. Do not have districts snake past each other to select voters. As an example, see Congressional Districts 2 and 6 as they snake their way up and down the Mississippi river. District 6 should be in the Baton Rouge area and District 2 should be in the New Orleans area, for example.
3. Legislators should not pick the voters – the voters should do the electing.
4. Districts should be built to REQUIRE a candidate to be willing to talk to all people, not just those in their party. We need compromise among elected officials, not this constant battling and name calling.
5. It is time for fairness, not the constant bickering we have today.
6. But mostly remember, the voters should elect the officials. The officials should not do the selecting.
