My name is Randy Briggs and I am in my second term as the Grant Parish Clerk of Court. I am writing you in regards to the impending reapportionment legislation that will be brought before your committee in 2022. In my former capacity as Parish Manager/President, I became intimately familiar, on the local level, with the huge task that you have before you. Reapportionment is never easy and it is almost impossible to please everyone. However, I am confident that you will accomplish your mission with the skill and attention that is required.
