Representative John M. Stefanski:

I am writing to you as the chairman of the House and Governmental Affairs Committee to express my concern regarding the potential redistricting of House District 22. I realize the Legislature is tasked with drawing districts based upon population. However, I encourage you to consider that this is difficult time for elections given voter apathy. I am concerned that significant changes to the district would result in voter confusion as well as potentially diluting the voice of the rural communities situated in District 22, particularly those in Grant Parish. Voters in Grant Parish are accustomed to having a single representative, which makes it easier for voters to maintain contact with their legislator. Currently, Grant Parish is divided into 3 different senatorial districts. I find that most residents are confused about who their senator is. I would hope to not have that issue with our representative in the future.
