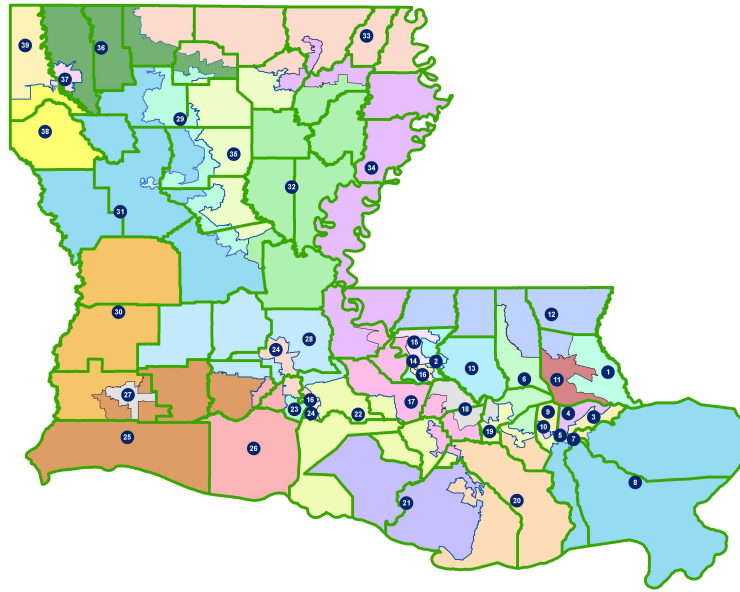

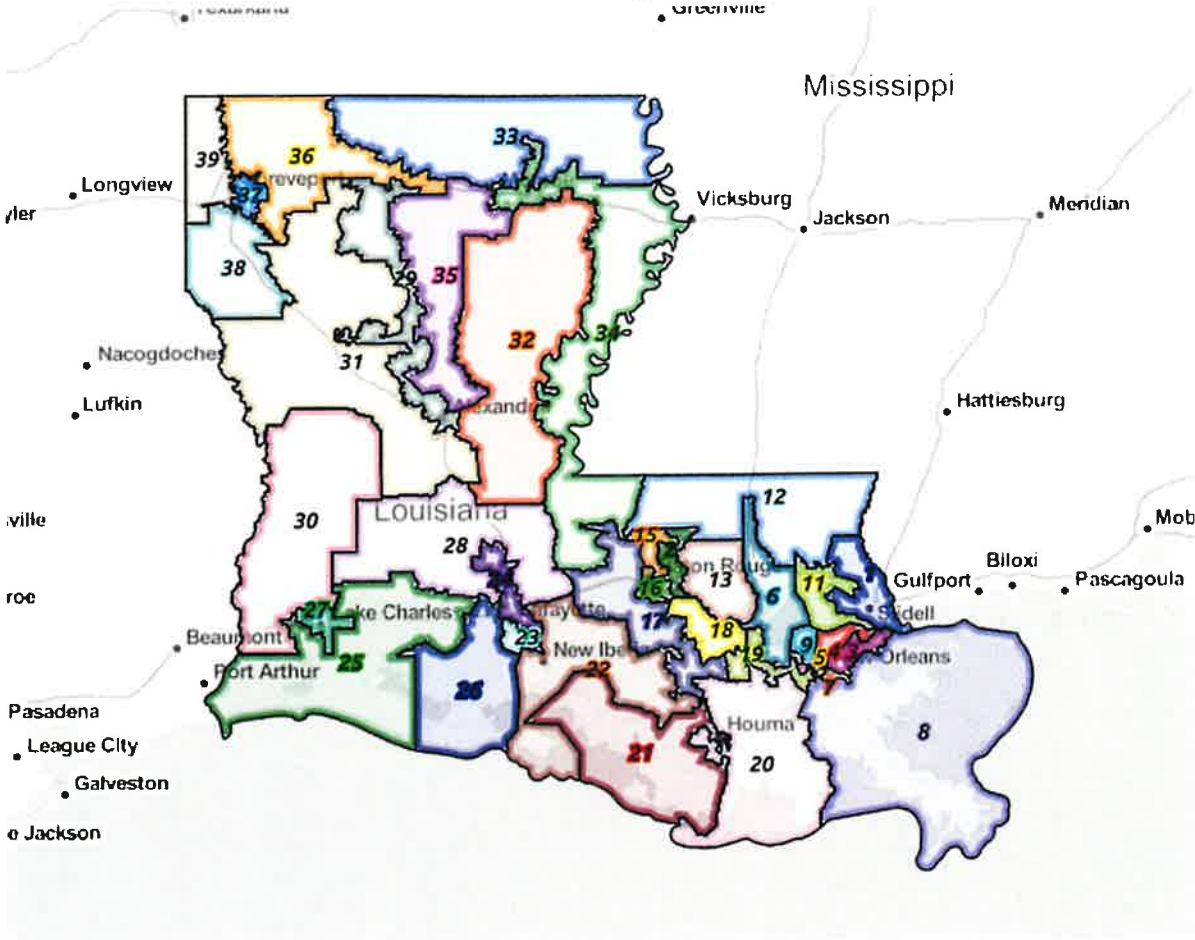

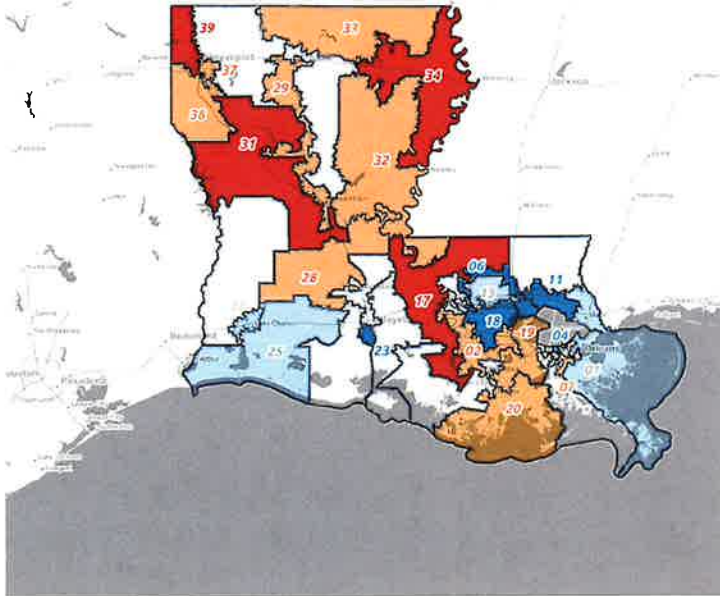

Principles

Plan 3A is the third of a collection of three plans. In addition to the following principles inherited from Plan 1A, its **main goal is to move low population District 2 to the high growth east Baton Rouge Suburbs and have District 17 and District 19 take over its former areas.**

- Districts must be within 5% of 119,430 target
- Old district lines must be preserved, if possible.
- The use of parish lines is encouraged
- The number of Black and/or Minority VAP majority districts should grow
- The number of Black and/or Minority districts, where group VAP is over 40%, should grow
- Competitive districts are encouraged
- Inclusion of previous incumbents are encouraged
- Precincts are split, only if necessary, on highways or natural features.

A look at the relative population between districts drawn in 2011 illustrates the large growth of population between Baton Rouge and the North Shore versus Districts in North and Central Louisiana.

Demographic Balance

This collection of plans seeks to increase minority representation. This plan identifies competitive seats as those with a voting age population between 50-60% and opportunity seats as those between (40-50%.) This plan...

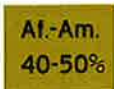
- Removes African-American Majority **District 2** from its riverside home and recreates it in the affluent suburbs of East Baton Rouge.
- In exchange, two African-American Majority seats are created from **Districts 17 and 19**. The result is a net-Increase of the total of **Minority (and African American) Majority districts by one**.
- Unwinds the packed African American community populations in **Districts 4 and 34**.
- Already a Minority-Majority district, **District 8** is now an African American opportunity district as well. Already a Minority-Opportunity district, **District 38** is now also an African American majority district.
- Creates a new minority opportunity in **District 17** and consolidates Native Americans to create a minority opportunity **District 21**. Thus, there is a net increase in one more minority opportunity district.

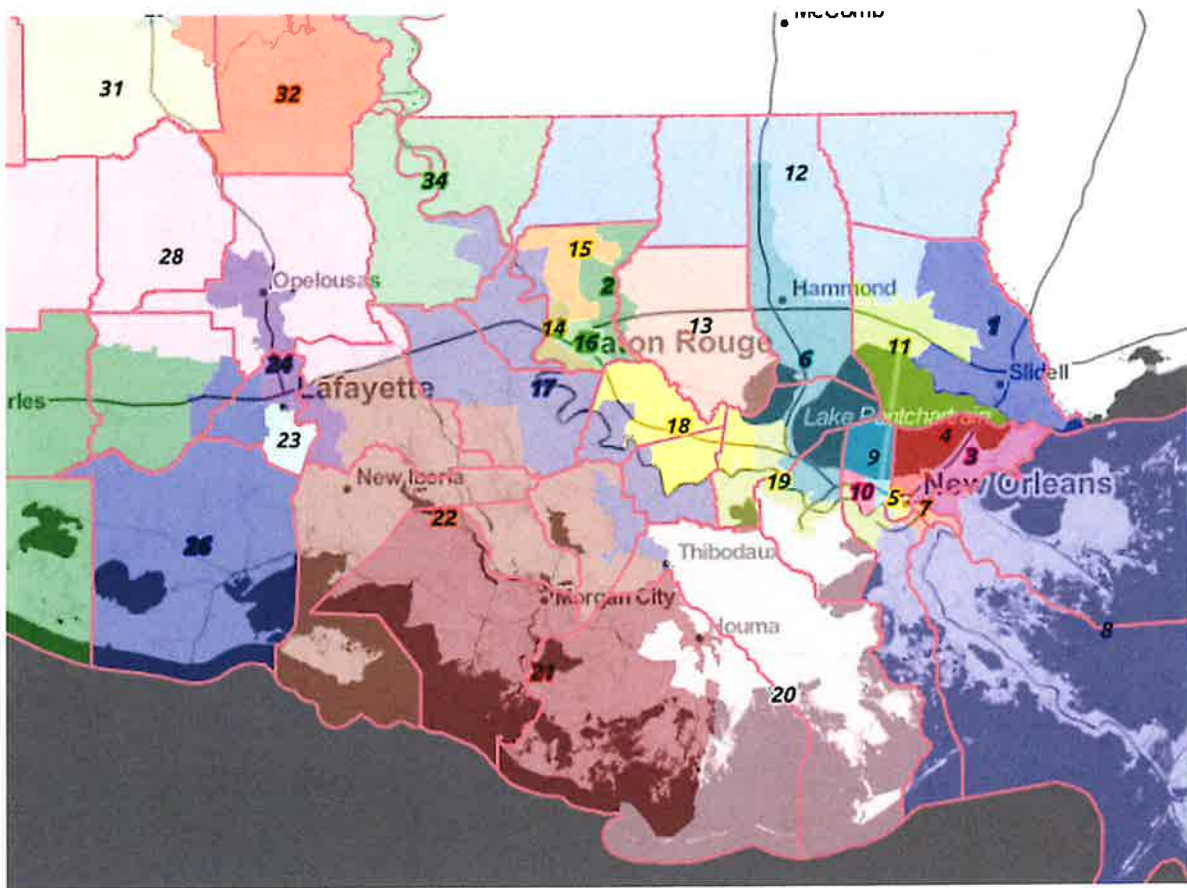

In Summary: Plan 2A adds two Minority Majority seats, 19 and 31, both of which are also African American opportunity districts. While the number of African American majority seats remains the same, new opportunity seats are created in 8 and 38 resulting in four new total African American opportunity seats.

Description of Changes

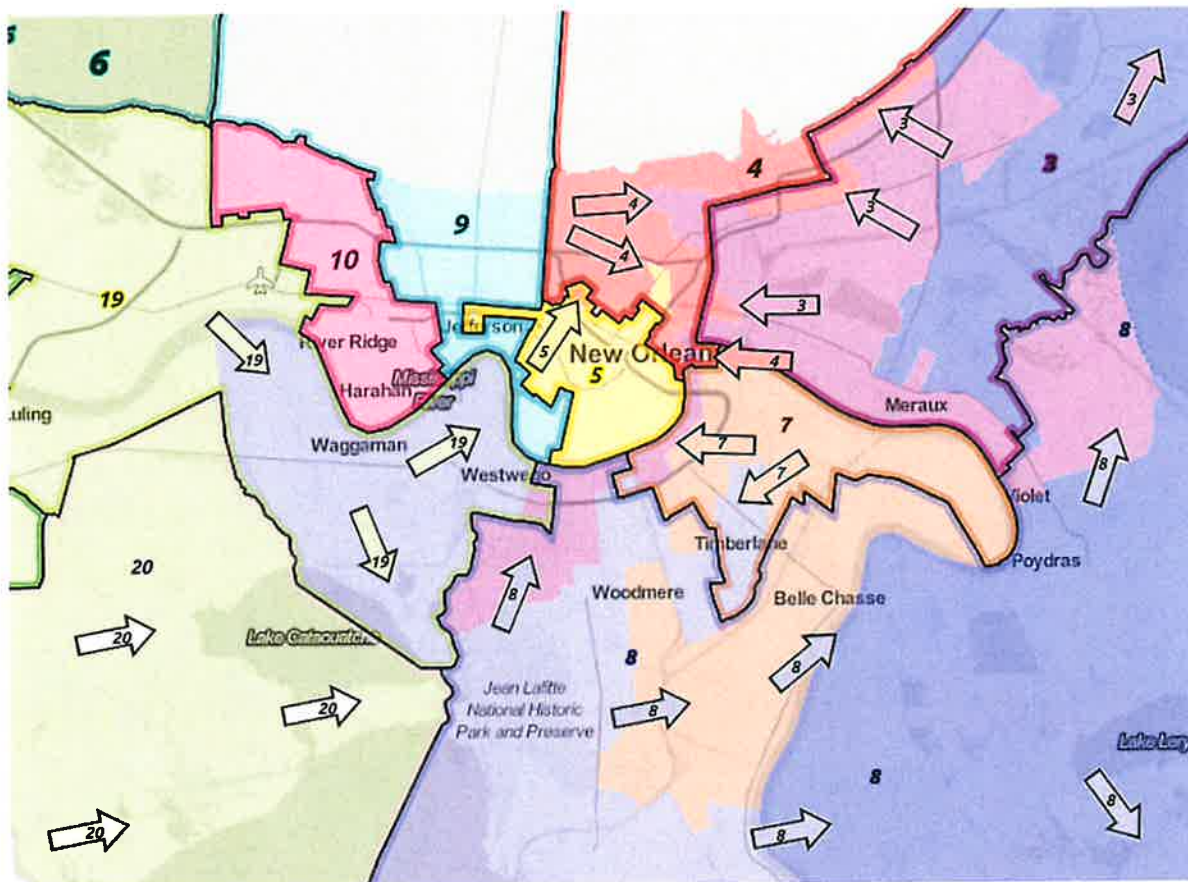


What follows is a description of the changes between the old plan and Plan 3A. The map above shows Plan2A's proposed assignments tinted by district and depicted with pink parish lines.

To balance population across the whole state, we must identify that the North Shore has the most extra people. **To that end, we take the most underpopulated district nearby, District 2, and move it to the North Shore.** Since this is an African American district, we compensate this loss by creating two new African American districts, **seats 17 and 19.** We must then carefully manage growing the areas of North and Central Louisiana districts and the accompanying contraction of North Shore district areas, all while balancing population throughout.

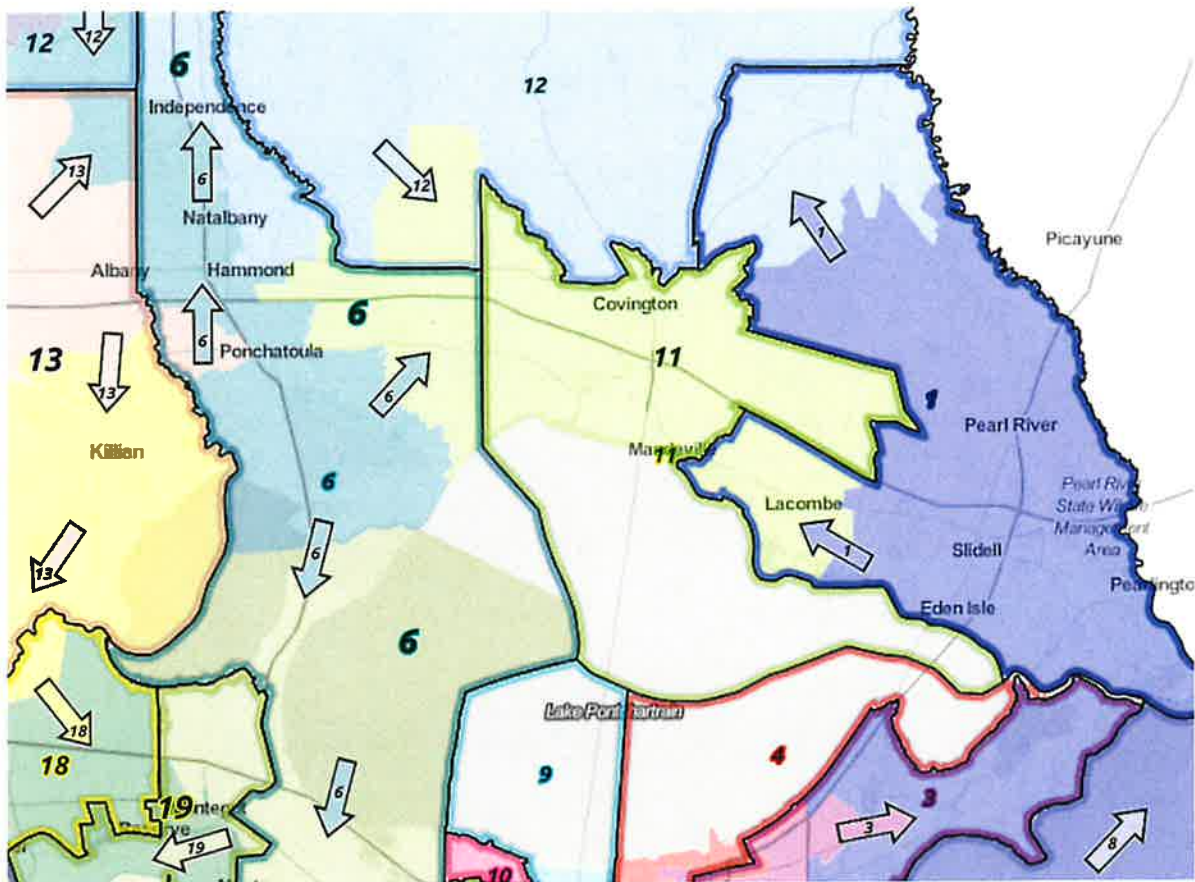
- In the maps below, the land is tinted with colors of 2011 district areas, lines of proposed 3A districts and arrows that show the changes that 1A proposes.

New Orleans



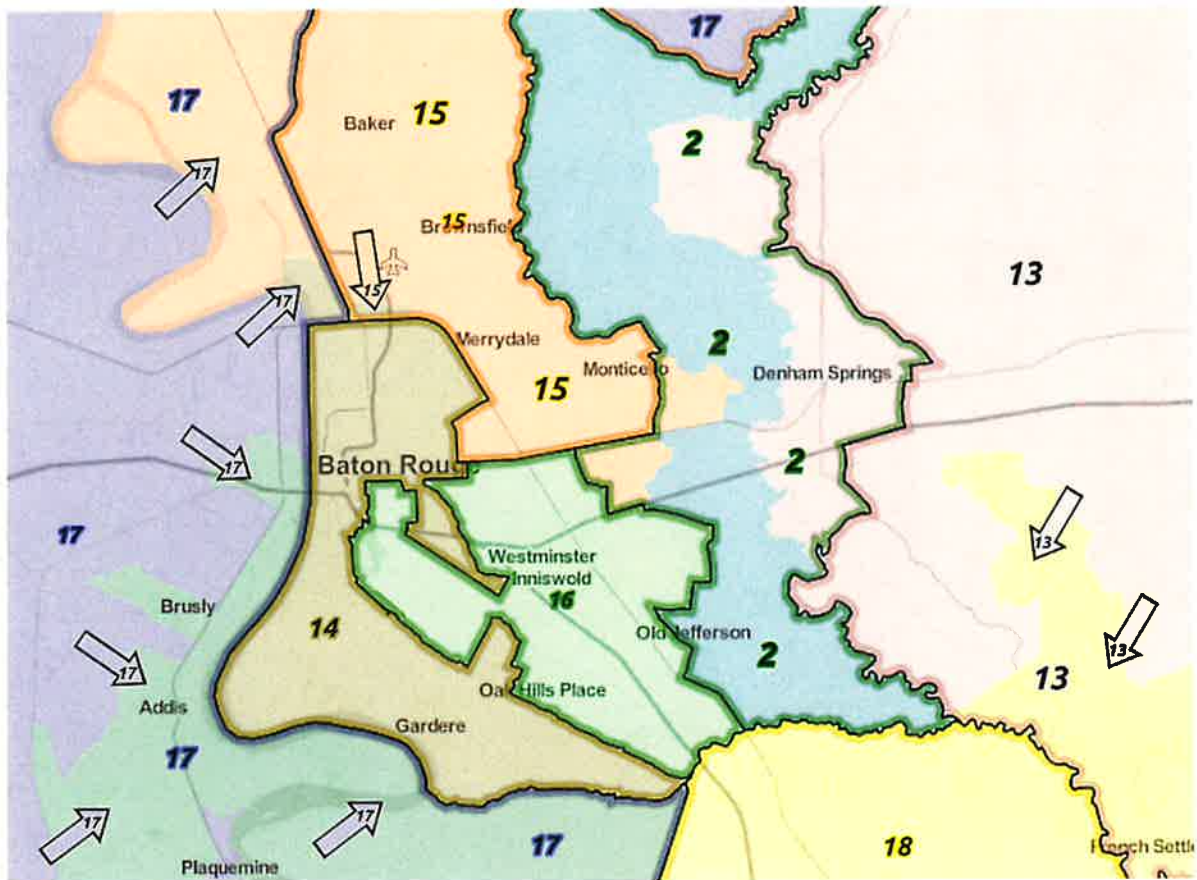
- The lines between District 3 and 4 have been simplified as much as possible to follow main roads and canals.
- **District 1** no longer crosses the Rigolets. Thus, **District 3 and District 8** now represent St. Bernard Parish.
- **District 3** loses its strange panhandle to **District 7** as it grows to find population. It jettisons Plaquemines Parish and represents a compact area in its corner of the West Bank.
- **District 8** represents Harvey and similar industrial communities in all of Plaquemines parish and lower St. Bernard Parishes.
- Jefferson Parish now commands much more of **District 19's** attention. More voters in **District 19** are now in Jefferson Parish than anywhere else.
- **District 4** acquires the entire French Quarter and annexes Hollygrove.
- **Districts 9 and 10** are identical.

The North Shore



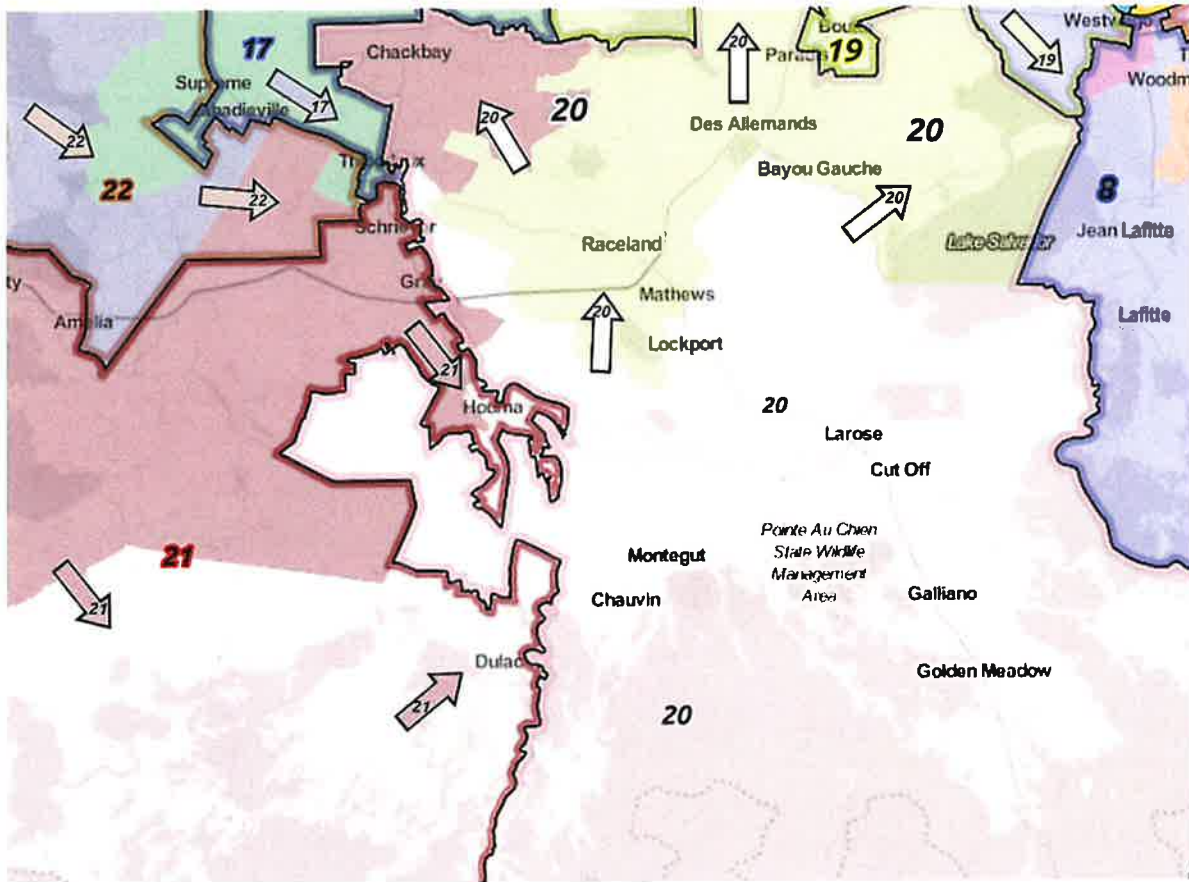
- Plan 3A's main aim is to essentially split the strange, gerrymandered **District 6** into two new parts. Its Western half is now the core of **District 2**. The new **District 6** will remain mostly in Tangipahoa Parish and seep around Lake Pontchartrain to collect population in St. Charles Parish.
- **District 11** has the most surplus people of any district. If we restrict it to St. Tammany Parish and give away Lacombe, it then fits within the ideal size.
- Having abandoned the South Shore, **District 1** makes up this population with Lacombe and other parts of St. Tammany parish.
- **District 12** expands into more areas of Tangipahoa Parish in addition to bending around **District 6** into St. Helena and East Feliciana Parishes.
- Laplace is now mostly consolidated within **District 19**.

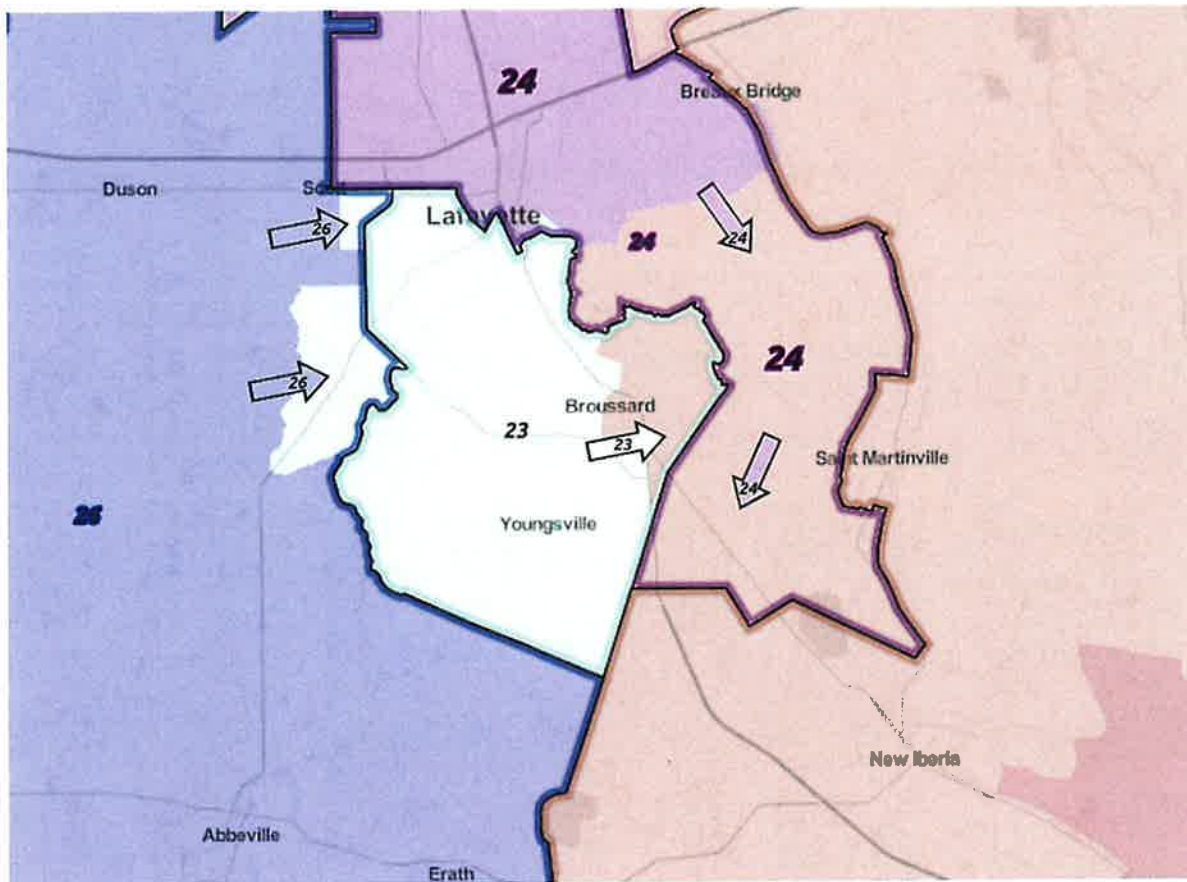
- **District 2** arrives. It takes most of **District 6's** western half and will be contained entirely within East Baton Rouge Parish, except for Denham Springs. **District 12** will take old District 6's northern branch together with the rest of St. Helena Parish.
- **District 15** retains its majority African American population while softening the packed votes by giving some people away to **District 17** and its other riverside communities inherited from old **District 2**. **District 16** doesn't change at all while **District 14** recedes from a few of its northern territories.
- Plan 1A tries to redistrict in this area with current seats, but requires more intricate changes to boundary lines to achieve this feat.

Houma and Thibodeaux



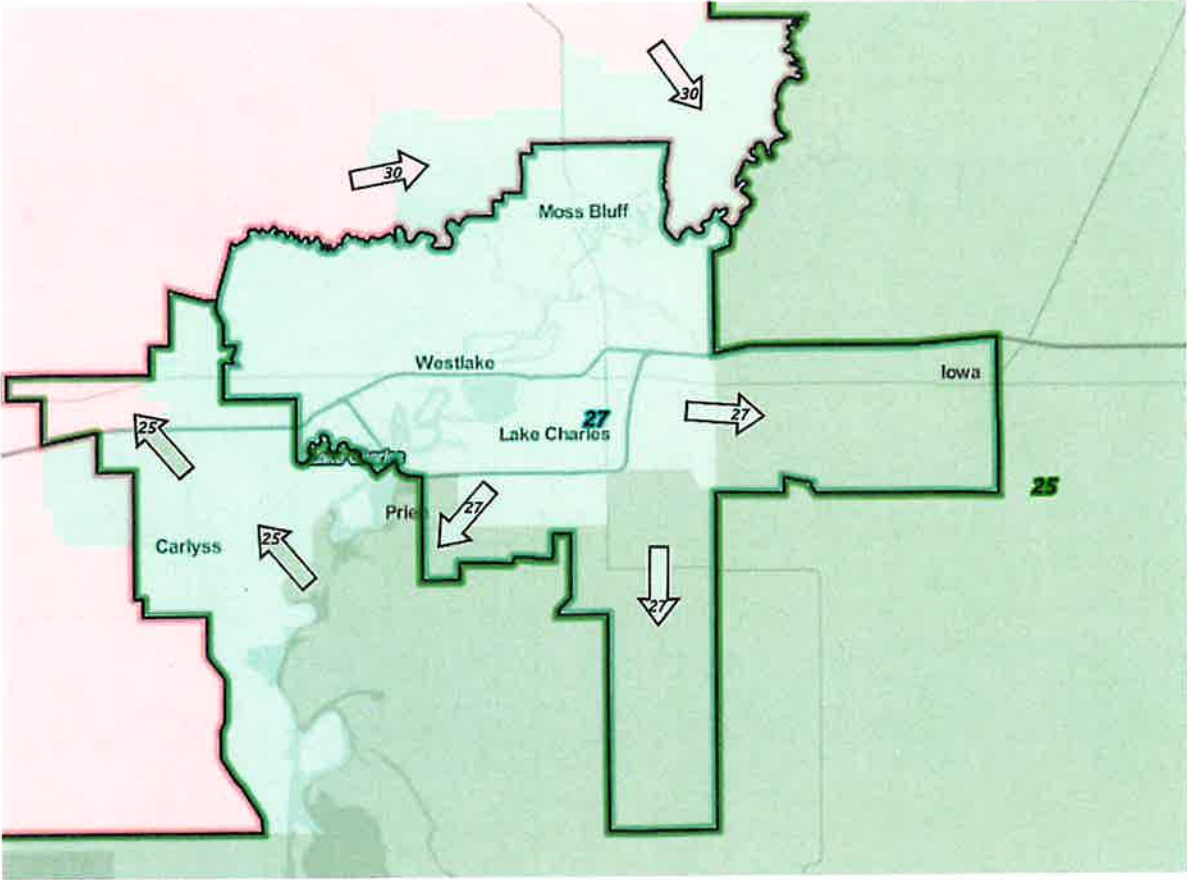
- As District 19 concentrates more of its population in Jefferson Parish, District 20 is able to move into 19's southern bayous, even picking up 21's former panhandle.
- District 21, having left Iberia Parish, carefully selects communities to become a unique place. It will have the highest concentration of Native Americans within a district, even if that concentration is 5%. That's enough, with carefully paired communities, to create an example of a Republican minority opportunity district.
- The St. Martin Parish exclave is reunited with its main area in District 22 which extends across the Atchafalaya basin.
- Not pictured, but Grand Isle is kept with the rest of Jefferson Parish in District 8 through Barataria Bay.

Lafayette



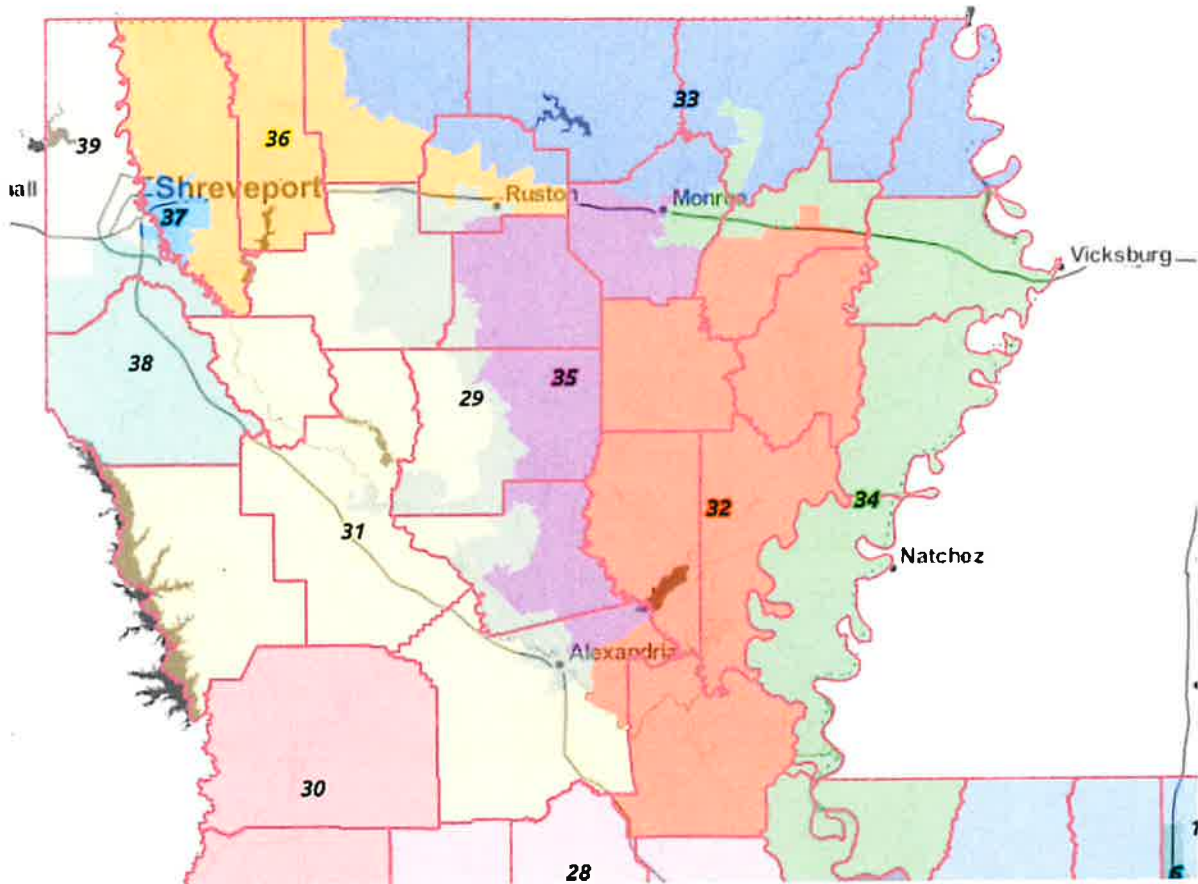
- The Southern Suburbs of Lafayette are among the fastest growing in the state. Plan 1A makes careful adjustments to **District 23's** boundaries such that it is defined by simple highways, rivers and parish lines. **District 26** absorbs most of this population.
- Since **District 22** must expand across the Atchafalaya to assist **District 17** in taking over old **District 2's** population, District 22 must cede its population in **St. Landry Parish** and some in St. Martin Parish to **Districts 24 and 28**. This extra population in **District 28** will help populate North and Central Louisiana districts.
- **District 24** remains majority African American.

Lake Charles



Since rebalancing requires adjusting districts from the South East to the North West, the parishes in the heel of Louisiana are mostly left untouched. Fortunately, **Districts 25, 27 and 30** are mostly balanced between themselves and adjusting between these districts is easy. Though it will always lean rightward, Plan 3A chooses the most mathematically competitive district possible around Lake Charles.

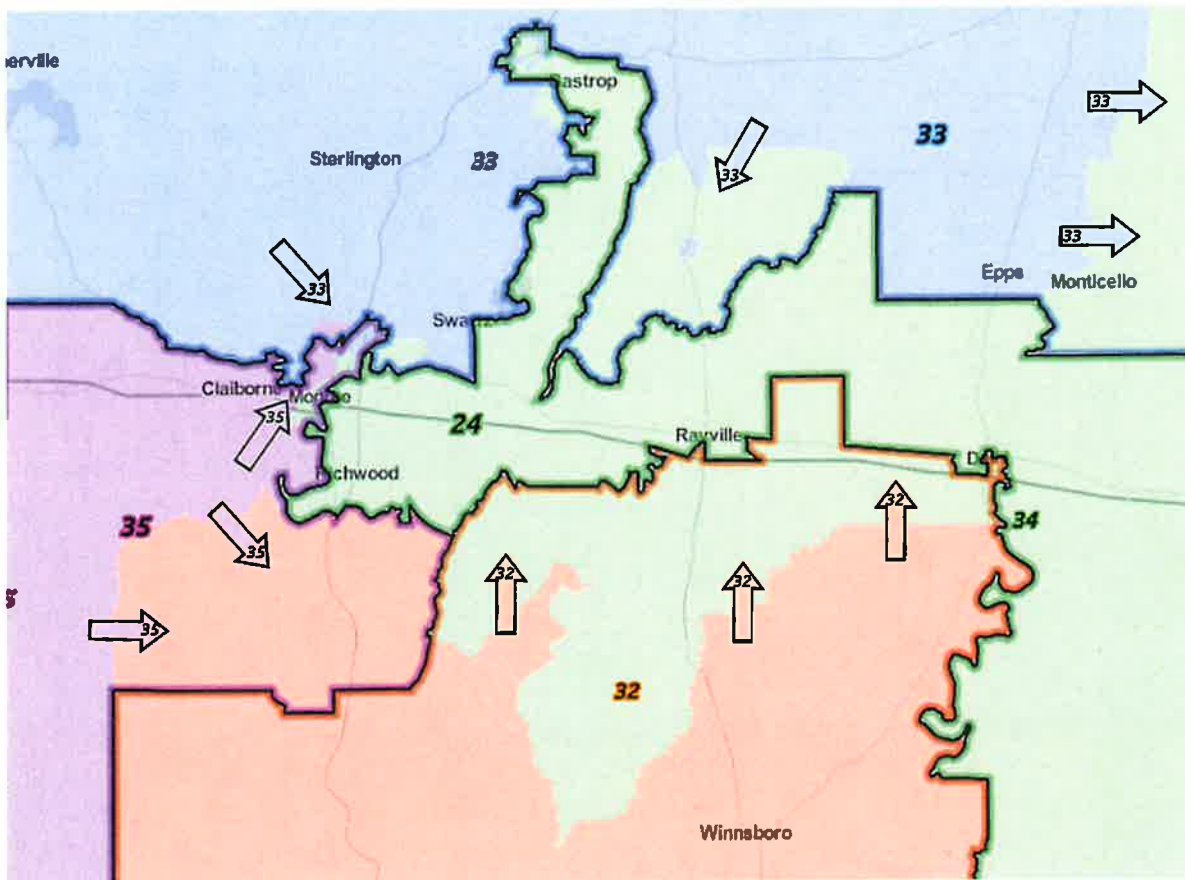
North and Central Louisiana



Here's another summary that focuses on North and Central Louisiana. The colors on this map represent Plan 3A assignments and are depicted with parish lines.

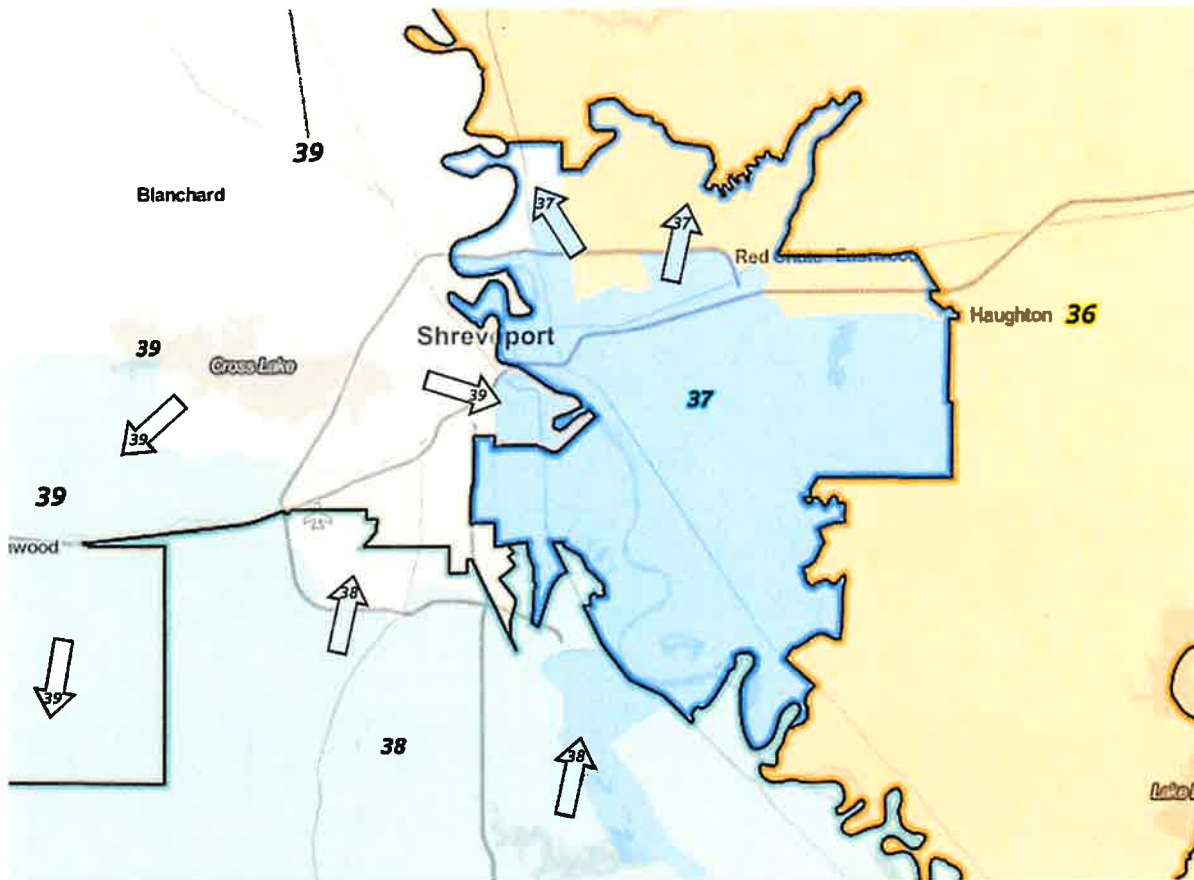
- When districts are underpopulated, they must expand to absorb more people. Since most growth occurred around the North Shore, **Districts 34 and 32** must expand in this direction. To grow, **District 34** takes much of Pointe Coupee and West Feliciana Parishes. (**District 17** keeps New Roads.)
- **District 32** takes Avoyelles parish from **District 28**.
- With these abundant populations, these swollen districts can cede people to underpopulated parishes like **Districts 31, 33, 35** and beyond. For instance, **District 34** cedes East Carroll Parish to **District 33**.
- This plan is careful to maintain majority-Black **Districts 34, 29** and identifies other opportunities for representation near Shreveport. Adjustments regarding communities of interests around **District 29**, are made near Alexandria and throughout the region.
- **District 31** benefits from these adjustments as well as expansion into Rapides Parish. Plan 2A describes a strategy where we move District 31 into the North Shore.

Monroe



Here's some detail around Monroe to show the dynamics between **Districts 32, 33, 34 and 35**. Having extended further south into former **District 17** territory, **District 34** now has too many people. It gives away much to **District 32 and District 33**, which allow them to share their population with districts like **29, 36** and ultimately **37, 38 and 39** in Shreveport.

Shreveport



- Though not pictured, it's vital to understand that in this plan, **District 36** takes over the area that was once part of District 35 around Grambling and Ruston. (**District 29** does not change in this area.)
- This allows for the Northern Suburbs of Shreveport to be available for **District 37** to expand.
- Then, this allows **District 39** and **District 38** to expand into these areas.
- This plan then creates an African American opportunity district in **38** by choosing communities carefully to reach a 40% threshold.
