Please see attached JC Harmon congressional redistricting map. Assuming that the legislature is intent on passing redistricting legislation, the attached map is in the best interest of the citizens of Louisiana. Importantly, and among other serious concerns, it is the only legislative proposal that will not seriously jeopardize our very narrow majority in the US Congress as well as our historic House Speaker and Majority Leader. As you know, conservatives have a two-vote majority, which is currently actually a one vote majority while Representative Scalise receives medical treatment and is inactive.

LACAG speaks for many citizens across Louisiana and is following this issue closely.
